**Whooping Cough**

We have had a number of cases of Whooping Cough at school. Whooping Cough is a highly contagious disease caused by the bacteria Bordetella pertussis. It is particularly serious in infants under 12 months of age, while older children and adults usually have a milder disease.

Symptoms may vary for different ages but initial symptoms are usually similar to a cold. Severe cases develop sudden attacks of repetitive coughing and often a characteristic 'whoop' as the person gasps for breath. Not all cases get the 'whoop'. Babies may stop breathing (apnoea). Vomiting often follows a coughing spasm. A person with whooping cough is infectious for up to three weeks after they start coughing. The cough may last for months. If your child has these symptoms please seek medical advice.

**Road Safety**

Parents please discuss with your children the importance of "**Road Safety**" as they walk, ride their bikes or scooters to and from

school. We have had a number of incidents reported to the school by concerned drivers and pedestrians about near misses because children are not following the basic road rules. Please continue to educate and re-enforce the importance of road safety to our children.
